Builds and fixes are custom-coded using semantic HTML5, mobile-first responsive CSS3 with fluid, scaling typography, JavaScript (ES6+), and PHP where applicable. Standard practices include WCAG 2.2 Level AA accessibility, cross-browser and operating-system compatibility with fallback support, performance optimization, and security practices informed by the OWASP Top 10. Where this engagement works within Client's Existing Environment, these standards are applied to the fullest extent that environment allows, and any platform-specific constraints are noted below. Full technical standards are set out in the MSA (Sections 4, 11, and 13).

*7.2 Hourly Engagements (Debugging & Optimization). **

- Standard rate: **\$40/hour**. Rush/expedited rate: **\$60/hour**. One (1) hour minimum per engagement.
- An itemized time-and-cost estimate is available on request — typically broken into diagnosis, fix implementation, and retesting — offered as a transparent courtesy, not a fixed price (see Section 7.4).
- Retesting and verification are included in the billed time for the fix; they are not billed as a separate line item.
- If diagnosis reveals a broader issue than estimated, work pauses for Client's written confirmation before continuing.

7.3 Payment Expectations. By signing, Client understands and agrees:

- Payments are due on the dates invoiced. Invoices are sent via Wave; no Wave account is needed.
- A 7-day grace period is provided after each due date.
- An invoice unpaid more than 14 days past its due date incurs a one-time \$25 late fee plus 10% annual interest, and may pause work.
- Final files, source code, and launch occur only after final payment clears.
- Full payment terms: see MSA Section 7.

7.4 Courtesy Estimates. Any itemized task, time, or price breakdown HC Web Labs provides — whether for a fixed-fee proposal or an hourly Debugging & Optimization engagement — is offered as a transparent courtesy to help Client visualize the work. Fixed-fee projects are flat-rate, not hourly-labor contracts: no refund or credit is issued if a task is completed faster than estimated, and no additional fee is charged if it takes longer, provided the scope is unchanged. Hourly engagements are billed for actual time worked; the itemized estimate is a good-faith guide, labeled as an estimate rather than a fixed quote.

7.5 Rates for Additional Work. HC Web Labs' standard hourly rate for additional or out-of-scope work is **\$40/hour**. Rush or expedited requests are billed at **\$60/hour**. These rates are confirmed in this SOW before any additional work begins (see MSA Section 8).

10. Revisions & Approval Process

- **Included Revisions:** this project includes two (2) design revision rounds and one (1) development revision round for fixed-fee engagements. A revision is a set of changes to work already presented — not new concepts, added pages, or expanded scope.
- **Phase Approval:** each phase requires written approval before the next begins. If no written feedback is received within five (5) business days, the phase is deemed accepted.
- **Additional Revisions:** rounds beyond those included are billed at HC Web Labs' standard hourly rate, with Client's written approval before the work begins.

11. Change Orders

Any work outside the scope defined in this SOW requires a written Change Order executed through BoldSign, describing the additional work, its cost, and any impact on the timeline. No out-of-scope work begins without written Client approval. Full terms: see MSA Section 8.

12. Scope Boundaries

12.1 Hosting & Server Access. Client purchases, owns, and maintains its own hosting and domain, and provides secure, valid access where needed. HC Web Labs does not resell hosting and is not liable for hosting downtime, server configurations that reject custom code, or domain-management errors.

12.2 Existing & Legacy Infrastructure. Where HC Web Labs works within Client's Existing Environment — regardless of the specific platform, page builder, or technology involved — HC Web Labs is responsible only for the custom code it writes under this SOW, not for pre-existing errors, third-party plugins installed by others, or hosting limitations. If the existing setup is too unstable to safely accept the new work, HC Web Labs will pause and issue a Change Order.

12.3 Google Business Profile & Analytics. Client registers and manages its own Google Business Profile and Google Analytics (GA4). HC Web Labs' role is limited to embedding a Client-provided tracking snippet.

- WCAG 2.2 Level AA accessibility conformance for all code created or modified by HC Web Labs.
- SEO implementation (best practices; no ranking guarantee — see MSA Section 16).
- Cross-browser and operating-system testing with fallback support.

- For fixed-fee projects: two (2) design and one (1) development revision round.
- For Debugging & Optimization: an itemized diagnosis-fix-retest estimate on request, with retesting included in billed time.
- 7–14 days post-launch warranty and complimentary minor edits (see MSA Section 15).
- Final source files delivered upon full payment.
